Don't Miss The Opportunity To Be Seen at the 12th Annual Caribbean Fine Art Fair!

Caribbean Fine Art Fair (CaFA Fair) - Barbados, the first international art fair held in the English - speaking Caribbean, takes place in Bridgetown, one of the Caribbean's most dynamic capitals. This annual event attracts art enthusiasts and collectors from around the world. CaFA Fair showcases works by artists of Caribbean ancestry, including those at home and those living and working outside of the region.

Due to the ongoing worldwide COVID-19 pandemic, the organizers of CaFA will again utilize our digital platform for 2022. Exhibitors will gain visibility with collectors looking specifically for art from the Caribbean region as well as those searching for new works to complement existing collections. We are hopeful to have a complete return to the physical location, Courtney Blackman Grande Salle Gallery & Annex in 2023.

CaFA Fair is a curated exhibition where a distinguished panel selects works from invited participants. The show features more than 40 exhibitors, representing the finest in Caribbean art, as well as select artists from the global Diaspora.

To be a part of CaFA Fair Barbados 2022, you must first submit an Exhibitor Artist Application. If your work is selected, you will be invited to exhibit at CaFA Fair Barbados 2022.

Who Should Apply

Institutions representing artists of Caribbean heritage, individual artists, and artist associations may apply. Please note that acceptance is based on the Selection Committee's recommendations. For this cycle, our Selection Committee consists of CaFA Fair Directors; Zoe Osborne, Mahogany Culture, Barbados; Pepe Coronado, Coronado Print Studio, USA

Selection Process and Criteria

Each Applicant Must Submit the Following:

- *For Arts Associations and Institutions:* a completed Exhibitor Application accompanied by a list of the artist(s) to be shown with four (4) images of each artist's work (digital images only), and a current bio for each. Institutions are limited to submission of maximum 3 artists.
- *For Individual Artists:* a completed Exhibitor Application accompanied by four (4) images of the artist's work and a current bio.
- **PLEASE NOTE THAT** images submitted should be of artwork available for sale at CaFA Fair. Artists' selections will be based on artwork submitted only. **Replacement of any of the selected works can be made only with approval of CaFA Fair.**
- Each Participating Artist Application must be accompanied by a fee of \$50 US (BDS\$100), per artist. Application fee can be paid by credit card, international money order or bank draft.
- All applications must be submitted by November 30, 2021. The Selection Committee's decisions are final and selected exhibitors will be notified by Monday, December 13, 2021.

Responsibility of Artists

- Selected artists are required to provide final images of artworks for exhibit by January 15, 2022.
- Selected artists will be responsible for the delivery/shipping of artwork to collectors who purchase the works on our digital platform. CaFA Fair suggests that artists also provide a Certificate of Authenticity to buyers.

Responsibility of CaFA Fair

CaFA Fair will:

- Provide a state-of-the-art digital platform for presentation of artworks submitted.
- Be responsible for promotion, design and management of the Fair.
- Provide sales assistance, including collection of payments for all consigned artwork sold.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Who Should Apply: Institutions representing artists of Caribbean heritage, individual artists, and artist associations may apply.

Selection Criteria: Our Selection Committee will invite and select established institutions and artists who represent art of high quality from 20th century to contemporary art.

Selection Process: Submit the Exhibitor Application accompanied by a minimum of four (4) jpegs or tiffs **of each artist to be shown** and a current bio. Materials will be returned only if accompanied by a self-addressed stamped envelope.

Works Allowed: Original paintings, mixed media, limited edition prints, drawings, sculptures, photographs, fine art jewelry, and video.

CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

- There is a non-refundable US\$50 (BDS\$100) application fee.
- Selected Artists have 2 options available; they may rent a virtual booth or consign the artwork to CaFA Fair.
- **The cost of renting a virtual booth is US\$500 and no commission will be due CaFA Fair.** If you decide to consign your work to CaFA Fair there is no upfront fee for the allotted space.
- **For works consigned to the Fair, CaFA Fair will retain a commission equivalent to 30% of the sales proceeds from bronze sculptures and artwork which requires fabrication and 40% of the proceeds from all other media.**
- This Application becomes a contract only when accepted by CaFA Fair.

EXHIBITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SELECTION OF ARTWORK

CaFA Fair 2022 is a curated exhibition with Exhibitor works selected by the CaFA Fair Selection Committee. Only the specific works selected can be exhibited. If an artist wishes to exhibit substitute works, the approval of the Selection Committee must be secured. Artists may be allowed to substitute approved new works for those sold on the digital platform for the duration of the Fair.

SHIPPING/DELIVERY OF ARTWORK

Artists will be responsible for the shipping and delivery of artwork to patrons who purchase their artwork on the digital platform. All costs involved in the shipping, delivery and insurance will be borne by the Artist or Buyer.

DESIGN AND INSTALLATION OF EXHIBIT

CaFA Fair has the sole right of designing the exhibit and will make final decisions on the presentation of each Artist's Work.

SALES AND COLLECTION OF PAYMENTS

CaFA Fair will collect payments for sale of consigned works. CaFA Fair will provide a report to each Artist on sales made and payments collected each day. Within seven (7) days of payment received, CaFA Fair will submit funds due to the Artist.

CONSIDERATION/COMMISSION DUE CaFA FAIR

In consideration for organizing, promoting, and managing the fair and exhibition of the Artist's work, CaFA Fair will retain a commission equivalent to 30% of the sales proceeds from bronze sculptures and artwork requiring fabrication and 40% of the proceeds from all other media.

PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

Artists who consign their work to CaFA Fair are expected to share the information providing access to the digital platform to their collectors, followers and associates. The organizers of the Fair and the artists selected are expected to exhibit the highest professional standards at all times.

This agreement is between the above-named Exhibitor and Diaspora NoW, Inc., (herein called CaFA Fair), and is governed by the terms and conditions as described.
